PROVINCIAL GRAND TREASURER'S REPORT

RW Provincial Grand Master,

I am pleased to report that the Accounts for 2025 again show a surplus with an increase over the prior year.

Our primary revenue stream is the annual dues payable by Lodges; these are driven by membership numbers and the amount charged per head, and a decrease in the former meant the amount receivable was slightly down on the prior year.

PGL dues receivable also include fees from Brethren receiving Provincial appointments and promotions, and the reduction in qualification period from seven to five years gave a one-off uplift in the number of collars awarded which produced additional revenue of £5,700. However, in 2026 this effect will reverse, it being the fifth anniversary of the Covid shutdown.

The increase in dues to be charged to Lodges for 2026 approved at last year's AGM is necessary to cover the aforementioned loss of income as well as additional employment costs and inflationary increases in other overheads.

The reduction in interest on bank deposits and dividends from investments reflects the downward movement in interest rates in the past two years.

The introduction of the new Provincial tie has been highly successful and has generated a large volume of extra sales. The use of a new supplier for the ties has allowed the costs to be kept at a reasonable level.

Our biggest overhead is employment costs and for the Office to cope with the volume of work it has been necessary to take on additional part-time support for a two-year period starting mid-2025. Other operating costs have been tightly controlled, with a small overall reduction despite rising inflationary pressures. Donations were lower than in the previous year when we contributed £6,000 to Festivals of other Orders in our Province.

Our portfolio of listed investments managed on a discretionary basis by stockbrokers Charles Stanley achieved a net gain in value over the year of 8.5% which is line with the relevant benchmark.

The Income & Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet below have been derived from Accounts for the year ended 31 December 2025. Those Accounts have been subject to independent examination by Maxwell & Co Ltd, Registered Auditors & Chartered Accountants, who have issued an unqualified opinion thereon. The full accounts, including their report, is available for inspection at the Provincial Office by appointment.

Thanks are again due to the two volunteer assistant Treasurers, W Bro Mike Greenwood and W Bro Barry Preece for their work during the year. Mike is Treasurer of our two charities: the Province of Hampshire & Isle of Wight Masonic Charitable Trust and the Hampshire & Isle of Wight Masonic Grand Charity (Tom Langton Fund). Barry not only provides me with invaluable support with the bookkeeping but also assists many Lodge Treasurers in need of help and guidance in the performance of their role.

RW Provincial Grand Master and Brethren; I am pleased to submit the following report as Provincial Grand Secretary for the year ending June 2026.

As always, the Provincial Office continues to be a busy environment in which to work with increased effort being made with the One organisation, One Journey allowing processes to be brought together and streamlined.

I can also report that although the Provinces' membership for the 12 months ending 31st December 2025 showed a loss of -15, this is a considerable decrease on losses over the preceding years and as at 31st May 2026 individual members stands at 7,557. This is a positive result to all of the efforts towards the '2022 strategy'.

Masonic Charitable Trust

The Province of Hampshire & Isle of Wight Masonic Charitable Trust (MCT) continues to provide immediate and invaluable financial and personal support to Brethren and their dependants who are experiencing urgent need.

The Trust provides a prompt response to one-off applications submitted on behalf of Brethren and their families through Lodge and Area Almoners to the Provincial Almoner. Increased awareness of the Trust across the Province has resulted in more Brethren seeking assistance and benefiting from the rapid support available for immediate needs.

The Trust is proud of its proactive reputation and remains committed to ensuring that Members of Lodges throughout the Province are fully aware of the assistance available in times of hardship. Its principal aim is to respond as quickly as possible once an applicant's circumstances and requirements have been identified and assessed.

Examples of grants typically awarded include:

- Financial support to assist with short-term hardship, including funeral expenses;
- Rapid assistance for health-related needs;
- Emergency funding for items or circumstances that may fall outside the scope of support available from the national Masonic Charitable Foundation (Freemasons Charity);
- Assistance towards the provision or improvement of disabled facilities at Masonic Centres and meeting places;
- Support for community and health awareness initiatives, including PSA testing events held in conjunction with PCaSO.

During the past 12 months, the Trust has supported individuals and Masonic charities through grants totalling in excess of £80,000.

The Provincial MCT works closely with the Freemasons Charity (FC), which is able to provide longer-term financial, family, and medical support. Applications to the FC are considered independently, although the Foundation frequently recognises the urgency of cases already being supported by the Provincial MCT.

The Trustees of the Province of Hampshire & Isle of Wight Masonic Charitable Trust remain fully committed to responding compassionately and effectively to the needs of Brethren and their dependants at all times.

The Provincial Grand Charity was founded in 1985 by the then Provincial Grand Master, R.W. Bro. Col. Thomas Bennett Langton. Having completed its 40th Year the Charity has once again been able to give generous support to numerous charitable and deserving causes in the Province.

The Fund Committee has met twice during the past year, and approved donations to 43 non-Masonic charities, totalling £23,040. The Grants awarded varied in size from £200 to £3,000 and these were made to support a wide range of projects and causes. The total amount of grants awarded and donated since the Charity was established in 1985 stands at £947,084. As at 31st December 2025, the Fund's value of investments totalled £965,991. Our stockbrokers have full control of our investments under the terms of business. They continue to monitor the markets closely to ensure that, subject to market conditions, they secure the best possible returns.

Under the Chairmanship of W. Bro. Ron Griffiths, the Fund has had another successful year with an increased number of Lodges making applications to the Fund. The ideal beneficiaries are small self-help groups with limited resources, especially those whose activities involve children and less able-bodied people, where a grant from the Tom Langton Fund would make a significant difference to their work and success.

We especially thank our Trustees for their advice and support, and of course the Area Representatives for their considerable efforts in promoting the Fund and presenting the various applications to the Committee on behalf of Lodges in their designated Areas.

Finally, the Committee wishes to express its sincere thanks to the Provincial Grand Master, R. W. Bro. Jonathan Whitaker for his support, and to the Provincial Grand Secretary and his staff for their valuable assistance during the past year.
